We will explore existing portions of the East Coast Greenway, including the newly developed pathways along the NJ Hudson waterfront, a NY Waterway Ferry ride into Manhattan, and the Hudson River Greenway from 39<sup>th</sup> St. to the GW Bridge. ECGA officials will come along to explain recent accomplishments and pending challenges to move the entire route off-road. We plan to get back to Fort Lee Park at about 1:00 PM. No fee for this ride but please bring money for food along the route and for the ferry ride (\$8).
