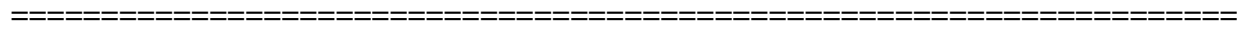


The East Coast Greenway in New York State

The East Coast Greenway Alliance seeks to provide bicyclists and walkers with a continuous comfortable and safe pathway through cities and towns along the eastern seaboard between Maine and Florida. Traversing parks and parkways and where necessary using low-volume roads and sidewalks, the 3,000-mile Greenway serves local and regional users as well as through-riders. Its “current travel route” completes the route on an interim basis.

The New York State segment will follow two separate routes that connect with the Greenway in Connecticut. Both converge in downtown Manhattan and utilize ferry or PATH service to connect to the Greenway in New Jersey.
