<p><i>Note: walkers and those cyclists who won't mind climbing a short flight of stairs have a more scenic option: remain on E River Dr Ext for only 0.75 mi, then L into Great River Park parking area; go through pkg area to path heading north along river for 0.55 mi, then use steps at R just before bridge overpass to ascend to Founders Bridge walkway to cross Connecticut River.</i></p>
