Become a member of the ECGA. A larger membership gives us a louder voice when calling for creation of new trails along our route.



Become involved with your state committee. Your state committee could really use your help! Lend your time, skills, or enthusiasm towards making the ECG happen in your state. Committee volunteers attend events, write newsletters, work on websites, scout new spots for the trail, and more.



Donate to the ECGA. You can donate to the national office, or your donation can help support your local state committee.

Join a regional trail inspection team. Help out by proofing cue sheets and inspecting our route.
